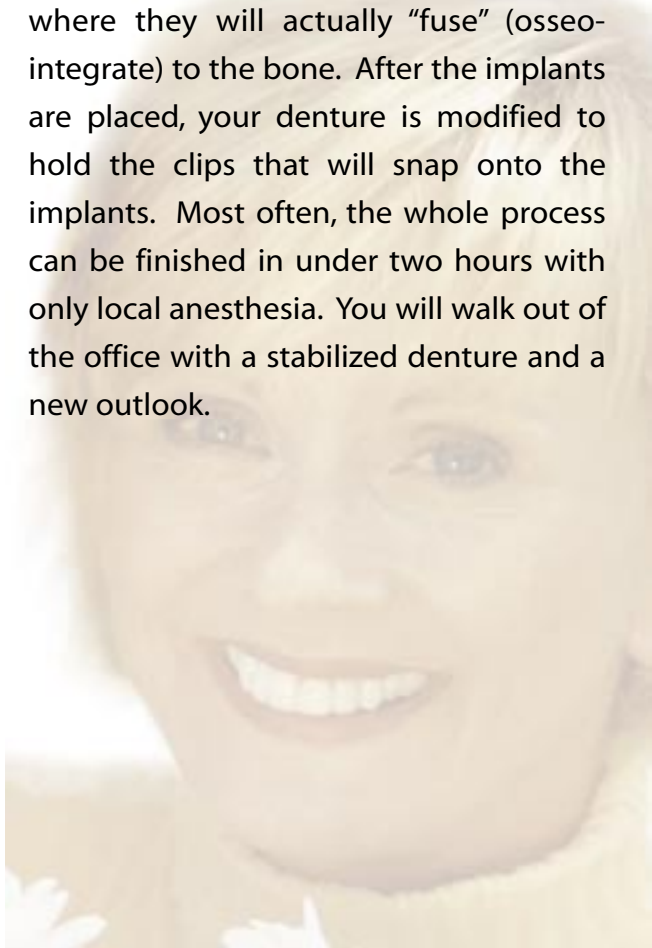


Dental implants explained...

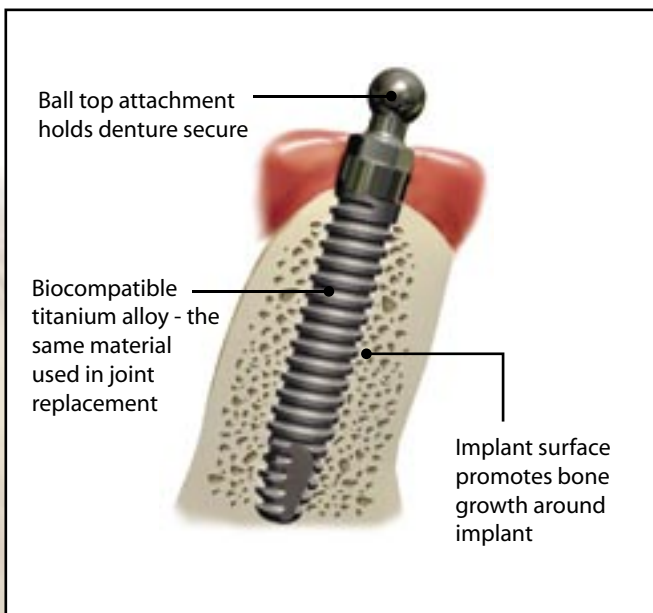
The use of dental implants to stabilize dentures has proven to be successful for hundreds of thousands of people. The number is growing daily as word spreads of the effectiveness and long-term integrity of the treatment. In fact, dental implants have the highest success rate of any implanted surgical device.

The procedure involves titanium alloy implants being inserted into the jaw, where they will actually “fuse” (osseointegrate) to the bone. After the implants are placed, your denture is modified to hold the clips that will snap onto the implants. Most often, the whole process can be finished in under two hours with only local anesthesia. You will walk out of the office with a stabilized denture and a new outlook.



What to expect afterwards...

Dental implant surgery is a minimally invasive procedure, and the discomfort you may feel should be minor. Your dentist may prescribe medication to alleviate any pain and may also suggest a modified diet during the initial healing phase.



Daily cleaning consists of removing your denture at night and brushing around your implants to remove any food and plaque. This also stimulates blood flow in the surrounding gum tissue. Following post-operative instructions and maintaining your dental hygiene are important factors in ensuring the long-term success of your treatment.

Security in placement...

Maximus OS implants have a ball-top feature that securely holds your denture in place by engaging clips that are permanently bonded into the denture. Seating the denture is as easy as firmly pushing down the denture onto the implant's ball-top - you will hear or feel it "snap" into place.



Welcome back to your secure smile!

The denture will be secure until you remove it for cleaning. Simply apply upward pressure to the front of the denture with your thumbs to unseat the denture. You never have to worry about denture adhesives again!

Implants and insurance...

Like most elective procedures, dental implants are typically not covered by dental insurance plans. However, your dentist may offer payment options that can bring implant treatment within your reach. The benefit of eating what you want, smiling with confidence, and the many other positive changes that dental implants can make simply cannot be measured!
